

Subject; Removing or installing air fittings from the air inlet of ASG Torq2 air tools.

Caution, When removing or installing air fittings or air hoses from the air inlet of ASG Torq2 air tools use either a 17MM wrench or an 11/16” wrench to hold the air inlet as shown in photo below.

If the air inlet is removed from inline push to start tools the cone spring and operating rod can fall out.

If the air inlet is removed from inline lever start tools the cone spring and ball can fall out.

If the air inlet is over tightened while installing a fitting or hose on inline tools the silencer can be damaged or the forward reverse valve can bind.

If the air inlet is over tightened while installing a fitting or hose on pistol grip tools the composite housing can be split.



Tools returned for problems related to this will not be covered as a warranty repair. Labor and any missing or damaged parts will be charged.
